Hazel recommended we consider giving new members packets of information about the guild. ¶ Final plans for volunteers for the Chimneyville Crafts Festival were discussed as well as volunteers and directives for the DGB exhibit. Angels for the CCF tree and weaving for the DGB exhibit were turned in respectively to Hazel and Gerry. ¶ Ginny Trainor mentioned possibilities of an exhibit after October, 1992, at the Marie Hull Building, Hinds Community College. She will check into security. Marcy added this could possibly be a location for Year of the American Craft. ¶ Marcy announced that Deborah Chandler, aka Debbie Redding, will be here for the Chimneyville Crafts Festival and will set up a showing. She will be representing Pueblo to People. There will be a party in her honor at Marcy's house on Friday, December 6. (More details later in the newsletter.) ¶ Marcy also announced she was planning future classes in plain weave (to include leno, warp face, weft face) and rugs and asked for input on moving classes from Monday to Tuesday nights. ¶ The program was about tapestry by Lucille Miller and was very inspiring. Some of Lucille's great pointers were: 1. You will never have time for weaving. You have to take it! So, set a clock on a table; set for 20 minutes. When the bell rings, get up! 2. Sign and then you're through! (How do you know when you're through?) 3. On commissioned pieces, don't take money until the piece is completed. Artistically, the piece will remain yours until you receive money. -- Margaret Pittman

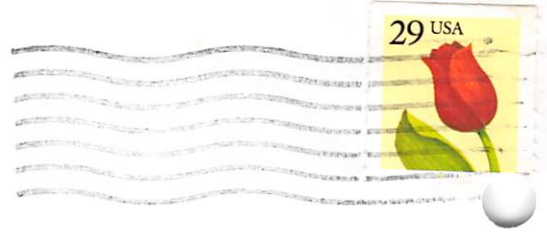
